Guidelines for Homework

1. Discuss your homework with classmates as much as you like, but write your homework solutions on your own! See later discussion of the honor code. And remember, you'll have to do the exams on your own.
2. As a scientist in training, you need to learn to communicate scientific information in an effective, efficient manner. You should consider homework assignments as practice in this art. It is your responsibility to present your solution in a readable, logical manner, not mine to decipher and interpret them. Write neatly and logically, and explain step-by-step how you are working the problem.
3. In keeping with (1) and (2), I require that you cite any work or results that you take from sources other than the textbook, such as the internet or other textbooks. Even if you find a solution to the problem worked out, remember that you will have to do the exams on your own. It is in your best interest to work out the problems yourself. If you worked with other people on your homework, cite this on your paper. Failure to cite other's contribution to your results is a form of academic dishonesty and will be treated as an honor code violation.
4. In an incorrect solution, I will reward statements in homework and on exams that show you know the solution is incorrect and why. I will also reward any effort above and beyond what is explicitly asked for in a problem.
