

Faculty Development Grant  
Interim Report

The purpose of our Faculty Development Grant was to incorporate information literacy components into Business Administration 320: Principles of Management (BSAD 320). During the summer of 2003 we revised the course syllabus to incorporate information literacy components. We implemented the collaboration in the 2003 fall semester with two sections of BSAD 320. A total of 57 students are enrolled in the two sections.

An information literacy survey was administered to both sections the first week of classes. Results will be tabulated at the end of the semester. Students will be given the same survey towards the end of the semester and the results of both surveys will be compared.

Three labs were scheduled during the semester. The first lab focused on general business publications and methods of accessing those publications: print, Internet, and via an electronic periodical database. Scholarly publications and advanced search techniques were the focus of the second lab. The third lab covered resources for locating company information. We are in the process of assessing the evaluation activities associated with each lab. Our final report will be submitted in January 2004.
