The system has been purchased and installed. Brackets for the receivers and cables to the PC's are available in GSC 241 and GSC 201. The software is installed, including the macro to link to Powerpoint, on the PC's in GSC 201 and 241. The RF responder system is in use this semester in PHYS 222 being taught in GSC 241. Anecdotal evidence from the students is that it is an improvement over the low-tech flash card system used last semester. I have discovered some small software issues with the responder system that I will not be able to address until the end of the current semester, but these should be resolvable. The Force Concept Inventory diagnostic test is only appropriate for PHYS 221, and will be used next semester when that class is taught as described in the initial proposal. I should have the results in early to mid-April. I am scheduled to report the results of this test at an April 28 Faculty Development Luncheon.
