Refreshments are available in the Friendship Room today from 8:45 to 11:00 a.m. All are welcome.

To help get better acquainted with each other, all worshipers are asked to sign the Welcome Pad. As soon as the announcements begin, the person seated by the center aisle should sign his or her name and pass the Welcome Pad on. When it reaches the end of the row, pass it back to the center aisle so all persons in the row can read the names of those seated around them. The purpose is to help learn each others' names, and to provide information for the pastors. **Prayer requests** may be listed on the card in the Welcome Folder and placed in the offering plate. **Hearing Aids** are available at the Welcome Center for use during worship services. Ask an usher for assistance. Please return the hearing aid after worship.

*All the baptized are invited to the Lord's Table. Come forward as the ushers direct. Take an empty cup, receive the bread and wine, place the used cup in the basket by the side aisle, and return to your place by the side aisle. For those who cannot take wine, take a pre-filled cup of grape juice from the silver tray. Lutherans believe that Christ is present in the Sacrament, and that through this gift, we receive forgiveness of sins, life, and salvation. **If you would like to receive communion, but are unable to come forward, please notify an usher, who will direct a server to bring the elements to you.***
