- ◆ Counseling is available for:
- ◆ Individuals and families facing the possibility of a loved one being imprisoned.
- ◆ Family members who have a loved one in prison.
- ◆ Couples who are separated by imprisonment.
- ◆ Parolees and their families who need support in adjusting to life with adjusting.

Who provides these services?

Counseling is provided through cooperation between Family Connection and the North American Baptist Seminary Marriage and Family Therapy Counseling program.

Services will be provided by a student therapist pursuing his/her Master's degree in Marriage and Family Therapy.

All counseling is supervised by advanced clinicians who are either Approved Supervisors or Supervisors-in-Training with the American Association for Marriage and Family Therapy.

The therapy relationship is a professional and confidential relationship. What is revealed in counseling sessions is confidential and protected by professional and ethical standards.

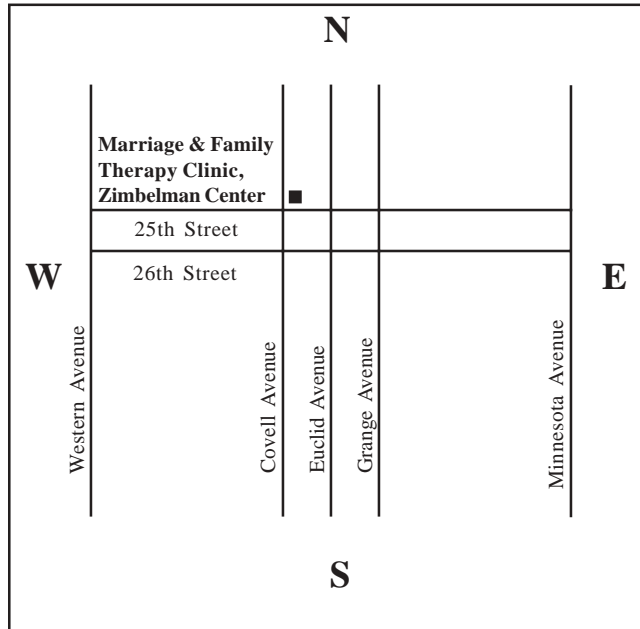

What is Project FamilyConnect?

Project Family Connect provides **free counseling** for families who have had or currently have a family member in prison.

- ◆ Marital/couple relationship issues
- ◆ Divorce or separation
- ◆ Behavioral issues with children
- ◆ Depression
- ◆ Anxiety
- ◆ Concerns involving other family members
- ◆ Referral for chemical dependency

Why should I consider therapy?

Families who have a loved one in jail or prison face many difficulties.

When the loved one is released from jail, the difficulties can be different but equally challenging.

We believe that counseling can help families cope with the challenges that they face so that they become stronger rather than weaker.

This gives hope that a cycle of problems can be stopped and individuals and families can thrive.

Project Family Connect can help you develop:

- ◆ Increased ability to manage or cope with relationships.
- ◆ Improved understanding of the impact of incarceration on your family.
- ◆ Strategies to manage or solve the problems you bring to counseling.
