Hospitality House

The Family Connection Hospitality House is a beautiful four-bedroom historic home built in the late 1800s. It is located one block from the historic district of downtown Sioux Falls. The house is about one and one-half miles from the penitentiary and within walking distance from the County Courthouse, Jack Rabbit Bus Station and a convenience store.

Four furnished bedrooms are located upstairs with a large bath. Downstairs, there is a small kitchen for preparing meals, a well-stocked play room, a dining room, a sitting room and a half-bath.

The house has been furnished and updated with generous donations from area businesses, churches, grants, private donations and with contributions from inmates at the South Dakota Penitentiary.

There will always be a staff person or volunteer on hand to help you with any questions you may have or just to lend a listening ear.



Our mission is to provide temporary shelter, emergency supplies, services and support to the families of inmates to encourage visitation and strengthen the family bond.

We are not affiliated with any one church, state, or local agency.

Q The legal names, addresses, and ages of all the people coming to stay at the house.

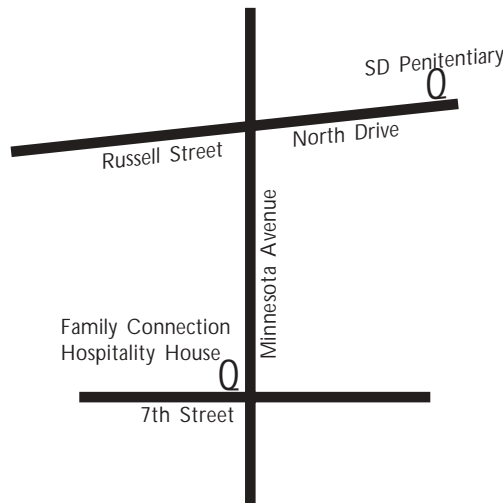
Q A phone number so we can call to confirm your reservation.

Rules and Regulations

Q Reservations for overnight must be made at least 48 hours in advance, so we may be ready for your arrival.

Q Please arrive between the hours of 8:00am and 10:00pm.

Q You are encouraged to bring your own food, but some basic food items are provided for you to use in preparing meals..

Q Smoking is permitted in designated area only.

Q Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, and weapons are not allowed on the premises.

Q We ask \$5.00 per night per family, per room. If you are unable to donate at this time, please don't let that stop you from being our guest. Your donation will be used to help our families who cannot afford to pay.

Q Out of respect of other guests, pets are not allowed.

Q We have information regarding visits to the Penitentiary on hand.

Q Your group/family may stay up to four nights.
