



Confirmation is the affirmation of one's baptism. During the confirmation years, students will prepare themselves to make the following promises to God:

- To continue the covenant God made in Holy baptism
- To live among God's faithful people
- To hear his word and share in his supper
- To proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed
- To serve all people following the example of our Lord Jesus

The confirmation ministry is a two year process that starts in the 7th grade. The two years focus on basic Lutheran teachings and the Bible in addition to developing a strong sense of faith and community.

- Attend **ALL** Confirmation classes
- Complete **15** Sermon Notes per Academic Year
- Acolyte when scheduled
- Complete community service
- Assist with Vacation Bible School
- Attend Retreats (when available)
