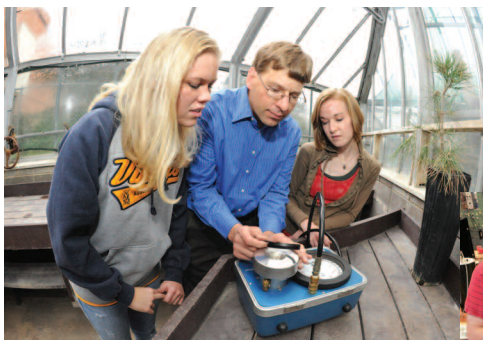

AUGUSTANA STUDENTS IN THE SCIENCES

The numbers...

- **43%** Augustana students majoring in the natural sciences
- **61** Record number of students who conducted grant-funded summer research in 2009
- **91%** Augustana's acceptance rate into medical schools across the country
Double the national average!
- **4,217,992** Grant dollars currently supporting research at Augustana
- **100%** placement of nursing graduates
- **25** number of students published last year as co-authors on peer-reviewed scientific publications

With Sioux Falls' emerging reputation as a biomedical research center, there are numerous opportunities for students to engage in the latest research activities. Students have also conducted research in laboratories throughout the country, including Fermi National Accelerator Facility, Brigham and Women's Hospital (a teaching affiliate of Harvard Medical School), and NASA's Glenn Research Center.



Students who have been involved in research dramatically improve their chances for admission to graduate and professional school. As a result, nearly every student who participates in summer science research activities and desires to pursue graduate and professional school obtains admission.

These exceptional results will only continue if, in addition to maintaining a remarkable faculty, Augustana succeeds in keeping pace with the facility demands of modern science education.
