

Housing Rates for Summer Housing 2017

Housing rates listed below are per person. Please be sure to read all of the information provided, as it may affect the rate you are charged for the summer.

Summer Housing Session 3 (Aug 4– Aug 18)*	\$325.00	\$225.00

Discounted Housing Rates

If you plan to work on-campus through work study, Grant or Institutional funding, you may qualify for a discounted Summer Housing rate. In order to be eligible, you must be working at least 25 hours a week in that position.

Additionally, please note the following:

- This benefit will be taxed according to IRS regulations.
- The discount will only apply to those months spent working 25 or more hours per week.

Additional Costs

Cable television is the only additional cost associated with living on-campus for the summer.

For Summer 2017, cable television is charged as follows:

Summer Housing Session 1 (June 4– July 1)	\$20.00
Summer Housing Session 2 (July 2– Aug 3)	\$20.00
Summer Housing Session 3 (Aug 4– Aug 18)	\$20.00
Total	\$60.00

As we only allow for one connection in each Apartment or Theme House, it is recommended that this cost is split amongst all residents of the Apartment or Theme House.

* Session 3, for the month of August, is available for students contracted to live on campus for Fall 2017 only. Any resident not returning to campus for Fall 2017 must move out by August 3rd at 12pm.
