What does my Hall Director do?

Hall Directors are professional staff members who live in each hall, oversee daily operations of each building, supervise the PA staff, and serve as on-call emergency responders for all of campus.

Additionally, Hall Directors serve as an excellent resource for students who are struggling to connect with their peers or the institution, are challenged by their roommate relationship, or are just interested in getting more involved on-campus.

Hall Directors are concerned first and foremost with your safety and security, but also with your development as a student and citizen. As such, they will work to provide you with the support you need, while challenging you to be a positive and contributing member of your immediate and larger communities.

Oh yeah, and they're wicked good at helping you find things to do when you aren't studying...

What does my PA do?

PAs (Peer Advisors) are second, third, and fourth-year students who have been carefully selected and trained to assist the residents of each floor, promote strong and healthy living communities, and provide opportunities for floor and building interaction and social development.

Your PA is someone you will want to get to know right away. As students, they are as "plugged in" to the Augie community as one gets. Like Hall Directors, PAs are an excellent resource for students who are

making that transition to college life. Even if things are going smoothly, your PA can offer great advice, connect you with additional interests, and be an overall positive influence on your experience at Augie.
