## REQUIREMENTS

In order to be admitted to the MDFL Honors program, candidates must meet the following requirements:

- French, German, MFL or Spanish major
- junior status
- · completion of one 300-level course in the target language; one course of comp/con suggested
- 3.4 minimum overall GPA
- 3.7 minimum GPA in MDFL major

Admission to the Program must also be approved by the thesis director and dept. chair, typically during the spring semester of an applicant's junior year.

## HONORS THESIS (FREN 400 or GERM 400 or SPAN 400, 1 credit, A/F grading only)

The Honors Thesis is designed with and approved by a supervising MDFL faculty member. The thesis allows students to pursue additional study and research in world languages, cultures and literatures. Students should select a paper from a previous 300-level course and, ideally, work with the same faculty member to expand and to improve their work; students should not select a new topic. The final version of the thesis should be 10-15 pages, including any bibliography and footnotes. A public presentation of part of the research in the target language is optional. A minimum grade of B+ is required on the final draft of the thesis in order for the candidate to be awarded Department Honors.
