A&P: CDF Requests: ACSJ/VOX discussed "V-Week", until the violence stops week. Sioux Falls Children's Inn and Rape and Domestic Abuse Center will be the recipients of the money raised. Asking for \$22 for cake and coffee provided at the session Monday. Tuesday there was a letter writing campaign where letters were written to the legislature, asking for \$55. The Vagina Monologues will be performed Thursday and Friday, asking for \$50 for drinks and paper supplies. Friday night there will be a dance in the Elmen Center with Sioux Falls schools invited, asking for \$190. Next Monday and Friday, processing sessions will be held which will discuss violence against women. They are asking for \$50 for snacks and drinks for those sessions. They are also asking for \$150 for the advertising for all of these sessions. They are asking for a total of \$517. Motion to allocate \$517 Lind, second Stobb, motion passes.

Augustana Women's Association would like to hold "Swing in to Spring," dance lessons for women. Augie Women's Association is asking for \$375 for instructors and \$45 for drinks. The total is \$435. Motion to allocate \$0 Jensen, second Bloch. Motion to amend to \$125 Barthelman, second Rogers, motion passes.

Augustana Women's Association is asking for \$100 to hold dinners for women only. Motion to allocate \$100 Stobb, second Van Bockern. Motion passes.

Augustana Women's Association is asking for \$600 (\$100 per session) to offer belly dancing classes for women only. Motion to allocate \$100 Barthelman. Motion to allocate \$0 Bloch, second Rogers. Motion passes.

Co-Curr: Discussed the Augie Advantage cards. They are looking to add a few more business to the card such as tanning, hair cuts, Canaries/Stampede tickets, carwash, Pickle Barrel, Spicy Pickle, Golden Bowl, etc.

Curr: Had their coffee with a professor with Joel Johnson today. The senior speaker will be worked on in March.

P&D: Claire Kosters will be replacing Philip Mulder. UBG head governor interviews will be Tuesday night. Luke Kosters still needs to be replaced, as well as Kayleen Stoesser.

Pres/VP: President: Spring allocations will be coming in next week. As a senate we usually make a recommendation for the student activities fee cost. Currently the fee is \$250, which includes various services that the college offers such as student health, the Elmen, etc. The senate receives about 50% of that per year. Discussion in committees is requested about a \$12 increase for the student activities fee to cover the cost of students receiving three major newspapers daily.

Also asked to discuss the CDF fund and see if we are using it correctly and just review it. Jesson spoke with Mary Toso who wants to know if ASA would like to do something for the senior banquet. She was also wondering if we would like to do the Faculty Recognition Award at the senior banquet. We would like to set up a task force, relating to the recycling efforts and one reviewing Augustana's sexual harassment policy and the procedures that take place within that policy.
