

## **Perry C. Page Memorial Endowed Internship Fund**

### **Description**

This internship fund honors Perry Charles Page, a native of Sioux Falls, South Dakota, and 1969 cum laude graduate of Augustana College. Mr. Page majored in math and business administration before earning his MBA from the University of South Dakota in 1970. He distinguished himself in commercial development in major cities across the United States, and throughout his life illustrated his passion for opportunity and education. Mr. Page is known for extending generous bipartisan support to individuals and groups, young and old. Augustana College, through support from Sally Ann Page, continues his legacy through a scholarship offering intern study in locations that broaden student perspectives and enrich future generations.

### **Criteria**

1. The fund will be used to pay internship tuition for one Augustana College undergraduate student per year, covering tuition for up to four credits of internship hours. (“Internship” is defined as “a structured ,practical learning experience that takes place outside of the traditional classroom for which a student earns college credit and which may be a paid or unpaid.”) This scholarship commences in fall 2009.
2. Augustana College sophomores, juniors and seniors with a GPA of at least 2.5 and with at least one semester remaining before graduation are eligible to apply.
3. The internship experience must be at least 250 miles from Sioux Falls, SD.

### **Application Process**

1. Applicants must complete and submit the application form to the Augustana College Financial Aid Office by January 10. Printed forms are available in the Augustana College Financial Aid Office as well as Career Center and an online fillable pdf is also available through the Career Center website.
2. Applications will be considered by the Perry C. Page Memorial Endowed Internship Committee, a team of four individuals appointed by the academic dean, to include three faculty members and the director of the Career Center. Each member of the committee will serve an initial term of two years and may be reappointed to consecutive terms by the Academic Dean. The director of the Career Center will be a permanent member of the committee. After the first two years, faculty members will serve staggered 1-3 year terms as indicated by the Academic Dean in his/her appointment.
3. Applicants will be judged on academic merit, relevance to future career goals, financial need and demonstrated personal growth.
4. The Perry C. Page Memorial Endowed Internship Committee will recommend to the Financial Aid Scholarship Committee by February 1 one student to be considered for this award. The award is to be made for the following academic year and may be used in fall, Interim, or spring.
5. Information about the scholarship will be available in all literature produced by the Office of Financial Aid at Augustana College.
