

Augustana Learn to Swim Coronavirus Policies & Procedures

We are working diligently to implement protocols and policies to provide a safe and quality learning environment for your swimmer(s) as we continue to monitor the developments of the coronavirus. Listed below are **some** of our operational changes for our Fall 2021 swimming lessons. We ask that you **please review the information**. Please note as things continue to develop with the coronavirus our operations are subject to change.

- **MASK POLICY:** Per CDC guidelines and Augustana University policy, **masks will be required for parents/guardians** once you enter the Elmen Center in the hallways of the building and while observing lessons, both in the hallway of the building if you choose to sit near the pool windows and the pool balcony viewing area.
- Families are responsible for bringing their own mask(s). Swimmers do not need to wear a mask as they are going into the pool area immediately and will be participating in lessons/athletic-related activity.
- Families will stop by the front desk to check in on the first day of lessons to make sure all payment and paperwork items have been taken care of.
- All families will be **required** to complete our **coronavirus waiver** before being able to participate in the Learn to Swim program.
- Our **locker rooms are open**, available for changing or showering before and after lessons.
 - Please enter and exit the pool area through one of our four locker rooms.
- Swimmers will be dropped off to a designated class space in the pool. The pool area will have defined spaces for each class to gather, specified by color, that corresponds to the color on the class schedule that will be sent out to families before the first day of lessons.
- We will no longer be doing announcements before lessons.
- Our staff will be cleaning and sanitizing toys, equipment, etc. between use(s).
- Our instructors and water assistants will be wearing face shields.
