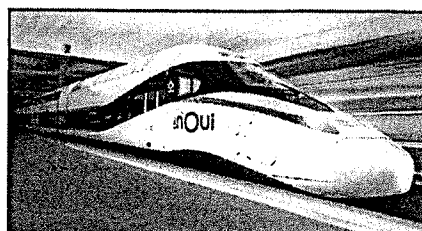


LANGUAGES, LITERATURES & CULTURES—LALC

major & minor checklist



primary language (circle one): FREN, GREK, LATN, SPAN **secondary language** (circle one): FREN, GREK, LATN, SPAN

With the permission of the LALC chair, other modern languages may be approved for the LALC major or minor.

○ MAJOR

- A required minimum of 35-37 credit hours, including:
- 23-25 credit hours in a primary language and 10-12 credit hours in a secondary language. Students who select Latin or Greek as their primary language must select either French or Spanish as their secondary language.
 - If French or Spanish is selected as the primary language, 320 or 321 is strongly recommended as a primary language elective.
 - Majors who enter the program at the 300 (advanced) level must complete a minimum of 10 credits hours from courses offered at Augustana.
 - Majors who meet eligibility requirements have the option to complete a one-credit Honor's Thesis (400).
 - Courses taken for the LALC primary language may not also be applied to a single language minor.

○ MINOR

- A required min. of 25-27 credits hours, including:
- 19-21 credit hours in a primary language and 6 credit hours in a secondary language. Students who select Latin or Greek as their primary language must select either French or Spanish as their secondary language.
 - If French or Spanish is selected as the primary language, 320 or 321 is strongly recommended as a primary language elective.
 - Minors who enter the program at the 300 (advanced) level must complete a minimum of 7 credits hours from courses offered at Augustana.
 - Courses taken for the LALC primary language may not also be applied to a single language minor.

A. PRIMARY LANGUAGE CORE: The following 15-17 credit hours in a primary language are required for both a LALC MAJOR and MINOR.

- B. PRIMARY LANGUAGE ELECTIVES:** MAJORS complete 8 credit hours of primary language electives; MINORS must complete 4 credit hours of primary language electives.
- French and Spanish electives must be taught in the target language.
 - 320 or 321 is strongly recommended if French or Spanish is the primary language.
 - MAJORS may not count LALC-prefix classes taught in English (LALC-297, 397) as part of the minimum elective requirements in Section B.
 - Courses taken in Section A may not be applied to Section B.

- C. SECONDARY LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT:** MAJORS must complete a minimum of 12 credit hours of a secondary language; MINORS must complete a minimum of 6 credits hours of a secondary language.
- Courses take in section A may not be applied to section C.
 - Students who select Latin or Greek as their primary language must select either French or Spanish as their secondary language.

GRADUATION REMINDERS:

1. Complete 124 credit hours with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0.
2. The last 30 credit hours must be taken at Augustana.
3. No more than 3 workshop credit hours may count toward the 124 credit hour requirement.
4. Complete the requirements for one major.
5. Complete the core curriculum—SOPHIA—requirements). No more than 10 credit hours from any one prefix (e.g. ENGL, FREN, SPAN, etc.) may count toward meeting the core curriculum.
6. Students will complete two courses with an integrated writing component, designated by a (W). In addition, students will complete one Communication (C) course as well as one Ethics (E) course.
7. Only language courses for which students earn a C- will count toward the *minimum* number of credits required for the major.
8. Students who take a course S/U during their last semester, and who pass the course BUT earn a U--which means that no credit is earned--will not be allowed to change the grading option for that course to A-F in order to have enough credit hours to graduate.
9. Students who are not majoring or continuing in a modern or classical language but who place out of one or more LALC courses are **only** eligible to obtain transcribed credit by taking and completing the course recommended by the corresponding language placement exam.
