Admission Standards: English proficiency requirements can be met by submitting a TOEFL (iBT) of 79 or higher, IELTS of 6.0 or higher, a Duolingo score of 110 or higher or by completing ELS Level 112.

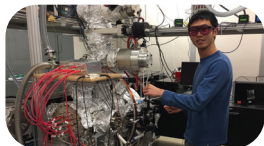
