### Please note the following exceptions to the above schedule:

- Classes that meet 4 days/week go with the MWF schedule for Exam days
- Finals in one credit hour courses are to be given during the last meeting of the class before final exam week.
- No student is required to take more than two tests in any one day/evening. Any student who has more than 2 tests scheduled for any one day/evening has the option of arranging an alternate time with the instructor for one of those tests.
- A student has the right to take a final exam at the assigned test period time during final exam week. The denial of this right should be reported to the Registrar.
- In case of illness, the student must notify the instructor prior to the beginning of the final exam.
