International student scholarships range from \$10,000-\$25,000 per year. On average, students pay approximately \$25,000 per year to attend AU.

Admission Standards: The middle 50% of AU students score between 1050-1280 on the SAT. English proficiency requirements can be met by submitting a TOEFL (IBT) of 79 or higher, IELTS of 6.0 or higher, EIKEN Grade 2A or by completing ELS Level 112.

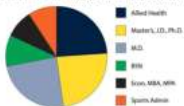
